

Instructions for davening without a minyan over the High Holidays 5781 - 2020

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(All page numbers are in the Silverman *Machzor*)

General Notes

- All recitations of *Barchu*, *Kaddish*, the *Torah* service and the repetition of the *Amidah* are omitted when davening without a minyan.
- *Piyutim* (rabbinic poems) that are inserted into the High Holiday service are not obligatory. Those that appear only during the recitation of the *Amidah* should not be included when davening the *Amidah* as a *Yichud* (individual). However, they can be recited after completing the *Amidah*. Examples are *U'netaneh Tokef* and *V'chol Ma'aminim*.
- Please note that the first day of *Rosh Hashanah* is on *Shabbat* this year. On that day, add sections designated for *Shabbat*, e.g., in the recitation of the *Amidah*, and omit the *Shofar* blowing and *Avinu Malkeinu*.

Rosh Hashanah: Ma'ariv

(Day 1: Friday evening, September 18; Day 2: Saturday evening, September 19)

P. 6-10 *Shema*/blessings before and after (Friday night add *V'shamru* on p. 10).

P. 11-15 *Amidah* recited silently (Friday night recite *Vayechulu* on p. 15).

Rosh Hashanah: Shacharit

(Day 1: Saturday morning, September 19; Day 2: Sunday morning, September 20)

P. 29-30 *Birchot HaShachar* (preliminary service)

P. 43-60 *Pesukei D'zimrah* (This prayer is called a *midut hasidut*, pious measure, as opposed to an obligation by the Talmud. If you want to only recite some of *Pesukei D'zimrah*, I recommend p. 43 *Baruch She'amar*, p. 49 Psalm 136, p. 52 Psalm 145 (*Ashrei*), and p. 60 *Yishtabach*.)

P. 61 Recite lines 3-5, then skip the rest of the page

First Day RH continue on p. 63

Second Day RH continue on p. 67

Skip p. 68 both days

Both days continue on p. 69-72

P. 73-77 *Amidah* recited silently

P. 94-96 *Avinu Malkeinu* (omit first day)

P. 117-120 *Shofar* blowing (if have *Shofar* – but omit first day)

P. 121-122 Psalm 145 (*Ashrei*)

Rosh Hashanah: Mussaf

(Day 1: Saturday, September 19; Day 2: Sunday, September 20)

P. 125-136 *Amidah* recited silently

P. 160-161 *Malchuyot* (*Shofar* blown on second day)

P. 164-166 *Zichronot* (*Shofar* blown on second day)

P. 169-170 *Shoferot* (*Shofar* blown on second day)

P. 175-178 Concluding portions of service (preceded by concluding *Shofar* blasts on second day)

(Day 1: Saturday afternoon, Sept. 19; Day 2: Sunday afternoon, Sept. 20)

P. 179-181 *Ashrei - Uva L'tzion*

P. 185-189 *Amidah* recited silently

(Sunday evening, September 27)

P. 262 Continue through p. 265

P. 331 *Av Harachamim*

P. 332-333 Psalm 145 (*Ashrei*)

Yom Kippur: Mussaf

(Monday, September 28)

P. 336-346 *Amidah* recited silently

P. 368-389 *Avodah* and Martyrology services (not obligatory)

P. 391 *Shema Kolenu* (not obligatory)

Yom Kippur: Mincha

(Monday afternoon, September 28)

P. 417-425 *Amidah* recited silently

Yom Kippur: Neilah

(Monday, late afternoon, September 28)

P. 448-450 *Ashrei - Uva L'tzion*
