Adas Kodesch Shel Emeth continues its used shoe collection drive. Together we are on a mission to help promote the importance of shoe recycling while raising funds for AKSE. Shoe recycling is easy, engaging and rewarding for everyone involved.

Participation is simple. We are collecting gently used (or new) shoes for reuse. A recycling collection bin has been placed in the lobby of AKSE. Simply “Bring your Shoes to Shul” and deposit them in the collection bin. All of the shoes we collect are sent to womens’ shelters, veterans’ homes, homeless shelters and organizations throughout the world that help those in need. From South America to Africa to areas right here in the United States, recycling efforts will help people and communities in over 50 countries. In addition, AKSE (and other organizations) receives funds for each pair of donated shoes that we collect.

Our community will benefit as well. Not only will your shoe donations help AKSE raise funds; they will also help keep these shoes out of our local landfills.

Since AKSE began participating in this program, we have collected over 14 TONS OF SHOES! Let’s keep it going.
